Cranbourne Harness Racing Club

CRANBOURNE CLUB 21 SYNDICATE

- Cranbourne Club 21 ('Club 21') will be a Harness Racing Victoria approved syndicate limited to 60 members and managed by a nominee(s) from the Committee of the Cranbourne Harness Racing Club ('CHRC').
- Club 21 will operate for a term of two years commencing 1 March 2022.
- Club 21 will aim to race four horses on lease. Initially the four horses will be:

NAKED AMBITION – aka 'Star'

5yo bay trotting mare by Andover Hall from Starcus NZ.

In training with Dylan Stratford at Cranbourne Training Centre.

Racing Record: 38 starts, 7 wins, 7 seconds, 4 thirds, \$77,770 prizemoney (as at 12 April 22).

COPACABANA – aka 'Lola'

4yo bay trotting mare by Andover Hall from Broadacrossthebeam.

In training with Greg Sugars and Jess Tubbs at Myrning.

Racing Record: 21 starts, 6 wins, 2 seconds, 3 thirds, \$37,440 prizemoney (as at 12 April 22).

THE FALCON PRINCE – aka 'Prince'

4yo black pacing gelding by Falcon Seelster from Western Gretel.

In training with Scott Ewen at Cranbourne Training Centre, 9 top 4 finishes in his last 9 starts.

Racing Record: 33 starts, 1 win, 4 seconds, 5 thirds, \$15,520 prizemoney (as at 12 April 22).

CLASSY COUNTESS – aka 'Tess'

4yo black pacing mare by Village Jolt from Ima Ritzi Lombo.

In training with Scott Ewen at Cranbourne Training Centre.

Racing Record: 34 starts, 2 wins, 1 second, 6 thirds, \$18,945 prizemoney (as at 12 April 22).

- Should any of Club 21's four racehorses be considered unviable by the manager(s) of Club 21, either through long term injury or non-competitiveness, another racehorse will be sourced to replace it and any such replacement will exclude unbroken yearlings.
- On the expiration of Club 21 (29 February 2024), CHRC will distribute to members all net prizemoney won by Club 21 horses during the term of the syndication.
Note that 'net prizemoney' is the balance remaining after the deduction of the trainer's percentage (7.5%), driver's percentage (5%) and lessor's percentage (33.3%).
- The cost to become an on-going member of Club 21 is an initial sign-on fee of \$150 plus subscription fees of \$100 per month. There is no GST payable on these fees and CHRC will invoice members for all payments.
- CHRC will endeavour to enhance the ownership experience for members of Club 21 by hosting exclusive social functions and stable visits at Cranbourne, and also by facilitating ownership privileges at other tracks when Club 21 horses are racing.
